#### Action taken report on decisions of last meeting

- 1. The Departments were instructed to submit the DAQAR 21-22 at the earliest.
- 2. Request for permission to extend the date of submission of IIQA and SSR to the NAAC was sent.
- 3. Meeting and interactions of Academic Monitoring Committee with Departments and staff has been scheduled
- 4. Recommended the College Management to complete repair and maintenance of the buildings in a time bound manner. The inauguration of the new Computer Laboratory will be arranged soon after completing the final finishing work.
