K K, Associate Professor of Statistics, a research guide at Kannur University, was a brilliant teacher and dynamic researcher. Their infectious enthusiasm, passion and commitment to their respective fields live on, and serve to be memorialized in the form of these awards. These awards recognize the best doctoral dissertations in the various streams of Science, Mathematical science and also Humanities, Literature and Commerce. The award is presented to researchers producing outstanding doctoral dissertation(s) in Kerala, theses that prove to be an insignia of excellence and inspirational research. The award is presented every year during the month of March at Nehru Arts and Science College Kanhangad, and carries a cash prize of Rs.5,001/-.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Any one who has been awarded PhD in the year 2023 from any institute/ college/ university in kerala can also apply
- 2 For the NASC Dissertation Award 2024 researchers awarded Ph.D degrees between 01 January 2023 and 31 December 2023 are eligible to apply.
- 3 Research work must be original and for the 2024 Award, priority will be accorded to applicants who have completed their Ph.D. degree in the specified subjects listed below:
 - (i) Science Physical Science, Chemical Science and Biological Science
 - (ii) Mathematical Science -- Mathematics and Statistics
 - (iii) Literature English, Malayalam and Hindi
 - (IV) Humanities History and Economics
 - (V) Commerce

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- 1 An abstract of the dissertation up to two pages in length written by the Ph.D. scholar, highlighting the significance of the research, the research methodology adopted and the major findings of the dissertation/policy implications.
- Soft copy of the Ph.D thesis.
- 1 A recommendation letter/nomination statement from the corresponding Supervisor/Co-Supervisor/Head of the Department/Institution stating why the candidate should receive this award.

- 4 Attested copy of original/provisional degree certificate (Ph.D).
- Obetails of publications in peer-reviewed journals, books and conference proceedings that are relevant to the Ph.D thesis (Copies of all publications to be attached)
- Reports from external examiners (if available).

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Submitted dissertations will be evaluated on the basis of significance of the research, potential impact on theory and practice, application, presentation and publications in peer-reviewed journals/ national or international conference proceedings and books. An expert committee is constituted whose decision will be final and binding for the selection of the award.
